

DC Ranch Neighborhood Park – Phase Two Submitted to the City of Scottsdale by DC Ranch Community Council on 10-15-2021

The DC Ranch Community Council is a governing entity that represents the 7,000 Scottsdale residents living in DC Ranch.

The Community Council's first priority for Phase Two of the DC Ranch Neighborhood Park is to have it tie seamlessly into our community and minimize impact for those living closest to the park. This includes low level lighting around the perimeter; any additional lighting to be tented, at lowest height possible for safe usage of the amenity and sited on the western portion of the park; an additional ingress/egress point to minimize traffic on Trailside View; additional trees or sails for buffer and shade; and use of materials and upkeep that adhere to DC Ranch standards. As most of the users will come from the adjacent neighborhoods, a reflective crosswalk at 91st Street and Trailside View is a critically needed safely element.

No one amenity/idea dominated input received by the Community Council. This determined our second priority – to encourage development of amenities that DC Ranch residents have requested and do not currently have free access to within DC Ranch. Suggestions that fit into this category are a shaded playground for youth 6-12 years old, a golf putting green, an outdoor exercise circuit/equipment and a sand volleyball court.

Restrooms, a water bottle filling station, bike racks, cool-to-the-touch benches, and sufficient doggie bag/trash stations are also needed.
