Executive Director's Report

- Westgate gatehouse repair under construction for the repairs from an accident.
- Park signage is complete in Arcadia neighborhood.
- Annual Election Timeline (see slide 8)
- Plant replacement has begun community wide (roughly 1,000 plants)
- New roses and replacement plants for Ethyl's Garden; top dress trees in park with new bark.
- 52 trees being replaced throughout the community (\$45,000)-Reserves
- Trimming of trees in Arcadia has begun-254 streetscape and park trees.
- Develop a cost analysis of conversion of poly pipe to pvc in the common areas throughout the community, it will be a phased plan.
- Completed renovations on Sterling Estate east courtyard fountain; beginning on west fountain in January.
- Directional signage inspection to occur this first quarter.
- Addressing pot damage at Jacaranda park; proposals for metal agave for plantings rather than hand watered plants. Weighing options on the 171
 pots community wide; daily watering; best use of resources.
- Open position on Budget and Finance Committee (two members interested)
 - There is a committee meeting on January 31 the committee will make a recommendation to the Board
- Arcadia sissoo tree project update.
- Sub-Association management update; Mike Wells currently serving as Community Manager; community painting project began Jan 3.
