

AUDITION INFORMATION

"The Wizard of Oz- Youth Edition"

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Location: The Homestead Community Center in DC Ranch, 18600 N. 98th Street, Scottsdale, AZ 85255. The community center is located on the southwest corner of 98th Street and Legacy Boulevard, one block west of Thompson Peak Parkway.

Audition Process: Auditions will take place in small groups and will last approximately 45 minutes. Actors will learn choreography and music pieces to perform in groups, as well as scene work. Actors do not need to come with any memorized material, but should be prepared to speak loudly and clearly. We are looking to cast about 30 actors.

Audition Time: Auditions will take place on Tuesday, January 21 and Thursday, January 23.

Please bring the completed Audition Form (page 3 & 4) with you to the audition.

Important Audition Reminders: Auditions are meant to be a learning and skill building opportunity. For some, the audition process can be intimidating, but this experience is meant to be enjoyable, not stressful. Please have fun and step out of your comfort zone!

CAST LIST

Parents will be emailed with casting results for their child during Jan. 27-30. We ask that you accept or decline the role via email no later than Feb 1.

COMMITMENT

The following outlines the commitment requirements necessary to participate in "The Wizard of Oz:"

- Performers must be available to rehearse from 4 to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesdays & Thursdays during the months of February and March with additional 4 to 6 p.m. rehearsals on some Fridays in April. Not every cast member will be required to attend every rehearsal. A tentative rehearsal schedule will be provided the first week of rehearsals.
- No rehearsal during SUSD Spring Break: March 10-14. We will accommodate other schools' spring breaks as well.
- Performers <u>MUST</u> be present for ALL days of Tech Week:
 - O Sunday Wednesday, April 27-30, 4 to 8 p.m.
- Performers <u>MUST</u> be present for ALL performance dates:
 - o Thursday-Sunday, May 1-4. Cast Party and Awards Ceremony to follow Sunday's show.
- Being part of a production is a commitment for both the young actor and family.
