#### Holiday reminders

Residents hosting parties should request that guests park with the flow of traffic and avoid parking in cul-de-sacs. Always allow for at least one lane of traffic in case emergency vehicle access is needed. Please do not park on sidewalks or block driveways or fire hydrants. Any overnight parking for guests must be pre-approved and permitted by DC Ranch. Fill out the <u>Parking Exemption form</u> on DCRanch.com.

The installation of artificial turf at Desert Camp Community Center was approved by the Community Council Board of Directors in partnership with the Sustainability Committee. Unlike natural grass which requires preparation, seeding, and ongoing maintenance, artificial grass can be installed quickly and provides a beautiful, low-maintenance surface. The anticipated cost savings in reduced water bills, landscaping maintenance and upkeep will pay for itself within three to five years.
